
REDF Investment & Advisory Services

REDF's **\$2m** of capital investment and advisory services have helped Chrysalis strengthen and grow its social enterprises, increase the number of jobs created, and improve the lives of more people.

Highlights of this partnership include:

- Created and helped institute a new program design, including specific term limits for Chrysalis Works and a more clearly defined employee flow model between Chrysalis Works and Staffing;
- Conducted a feasibility analysis leading to the launch of the new business line Chrysalis Roads, a litter abatement business that services highways throughout LA County;
- Devised and launched the Personal Employment Plan (PEP) assessment, a data-driven tool that allows Chrysalis to gauge and standardize client job readiness; and
- Facilitated Chrysalis' participation in LA:RISE (Los Angeles Regional Initiative for Social Enterprise), an innovative partnership uniting the city's Workforce Development System with nonprofit social enterprises and for-profit employers to improve outcomes for people striving to overcome barriers to employment.

Harlan was serving in the U.S. Navy when drugs became a part of his life. He had served almost six years when addiction caused everything to spiral out of control, and he spent time in jail. When he was paroled to a transitional living home in Los Angeles, he found Chrysalis and a new path. "Chrysalis is a blessing," says Harlan. He describes Chrysalis as a place dedicated to uplifting people and providing the opportunities for a better life. He gained experience that helped him secure another job with a company that maintains parking lots and structures in Los Angeles. "I am so grateful to have been given responsibility and to be trusted," he says. Working with Chrysalis renewed his sense of dignity in a way that only a job can.
